For Mid-Career PC(USA) Pastors

Is God calling you to something new?

Synergos is for mid-career pastors who are ready to explore something new in their vocation to the church. While pursuing an academic program, pastors will serve in a small-church congregation in the Synod of the Rocky Mountains.

This residency allows pastors time and space for mid-career discernment about how and where they will serve next. Placements include the possibility of long-term placement at each site.

About the residency:

The residency will run August 1, 2025 to July 31, 2027.

Located in a beautiful part of the country, the 2025 cohort churches are in Montana and Wyoming

Pastors are partnered with congregations who also are learning and discerning their long-term sense of call and strategic outlook

Residents will choose from a variety of academic options to pursue during the residency

Benefits include:

Full-time, 35-hour per week position with an effective salary of \$65,000 per year

Academic pursuit funds of up to \$7,000 per year

Annual Synergos retreat

Moving expense reimbursement, up to \$8,000 per resident

Participation in the Board of Pensions: family insurance, death and disability, and pension

Individual coaching and cohort support
