



Con-Ed Support for Presbyteries in the Synod of the Rocky Mountains

Presbyteries have a unique opportunity to pour into local pastors and ruling elders! Synergos (a program of the Omaha Presbyterian Seminary Foundation) is offering two fully funded educational events to attach to upcoming in-person presbytery meetings, now thru December 2028.

This program comes at minimal cost to the presbytery budget and is designed specifically to encourage and equip congregations navigating times of transition.

How It Fits the Schedule

These events attach directly to scheduled in-person presbytery gatherings to maximize leader participation:

OPTION A

The day right before the presbytery meeting.

OPTION B

The day right after the presbytery meeting.

Three Workshop Blocks

Each event features three engaging, 90-minute training sessions geared toward both pastors and elders:

01 Strategic Planning

Navigating long-term visioning and strategic planning.

02 Worship Resourcing

Deepening and refreshing the heart of community gatherings.

03 Consultant's Choice

A timely topic uniquely curated by the lead program expert at your event.

Generous Financial Support

Free Training: Synergos fully covers the costs for two expert consultants and an organizational representative.

Travel Scholarships: Small financial aid packages are available from Synergos for pastors or elders who need help paying for mileage or lodging to attend.

Presbytery Responsibilities

- Secure a welcoming host location for the event.
- Coordinate meals for the attendees, depending on the final schedule chosen.
